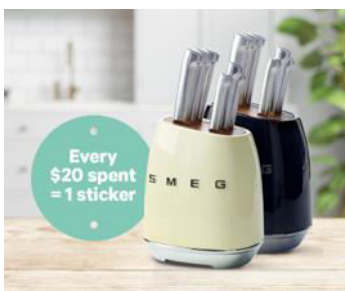
Despite the result, it was an enjoyable outing and great to be out on the green. We look forward to next week and another good game of bowls.

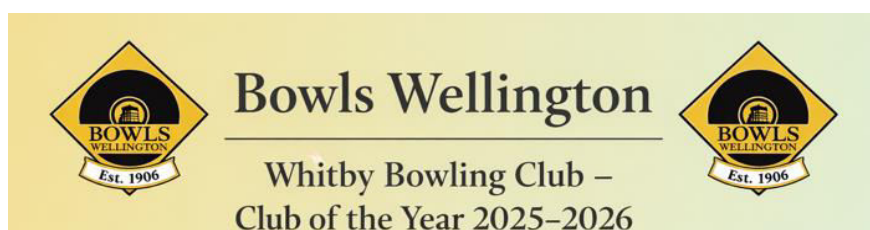


Members draw at 6pm. It was not won last week so the bar tab this week is **\$40**
